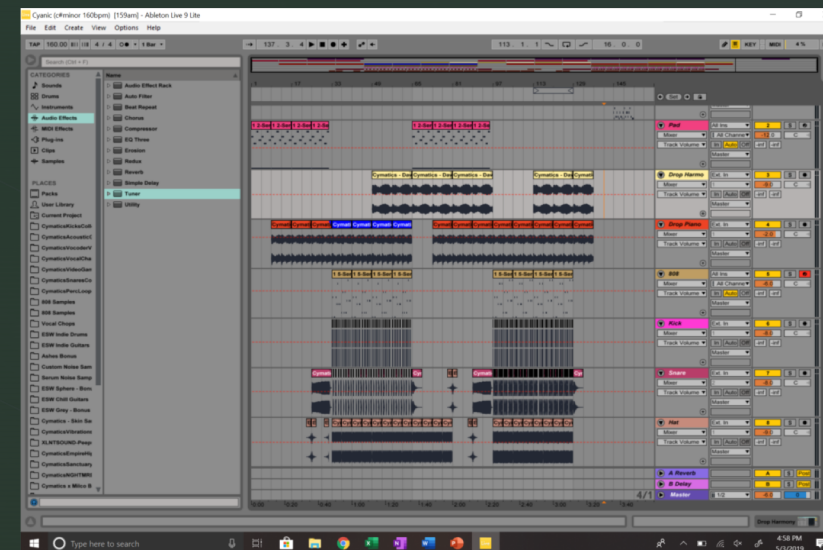
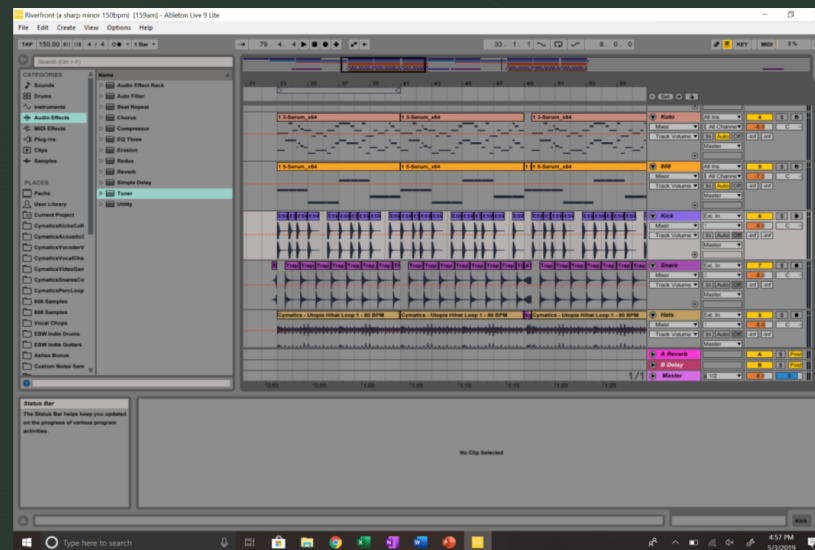


- I created the album cover before I started working on the music because I wanted the feeling of the songs to more or less reflect the feeling of the cover.
