Being constructed in 1914, Arena da Baixada has been renovated twice. Once in 1999 and in 2013 before the World Cup, it has been considered one of Brazil's most modern and best-appointed stadiums.

With all the new renovations added the stadium is set to hold 41,456 spectators. The stadium will hold four matches in the World Cup
